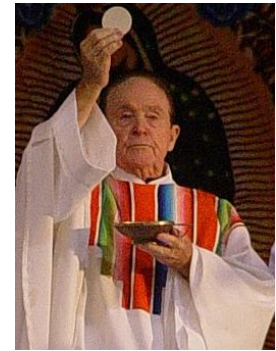

**Holy Thursday** the institution of Communion (First Mass) and the betrayal by Judas.

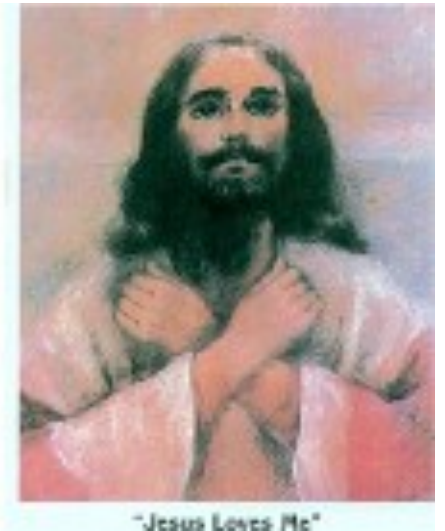
**Good Friday**, the arrest, trial, crucifixion, death, and burial of Jesus Christ.
